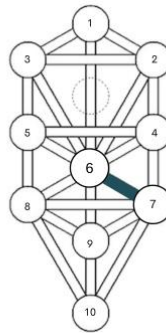


24th Path Death



The final 'Dark Night of The Soul' pathway, the 24th path. This is the path of death and re-birth, of transmuting your fears into acceptance or into change. Sometimes there are choices, sometimes there's only what is. You cannot stop a young person moving through adolescence, but there are choices they can make within the process. A rebirth requires a let go.

The symbols on this path are very clear, the Phoenix is an ancient one, death and rebirth and repeat. The boat is another, a symbol of crossing from one state of being to another; and back again. Become aware of any new patterns moving into your life, but they will require choices to be made. A spiritual truth, a spiritual choice may not be the easiest to make and only you decide.

You can rise to a challenge or join the ranks of plenty who, for whatever reason, choose to remain in the darkness.

Running between Netzach and Tiphareth the name of this path means fish. It's Scorpio in astrology and the Tarot card is Death. One of three paths that make up The Dark Night of the Soul it tests your ability to transform from personality reactions to soul led decisions. Run deep.

Activation

Be thankful for the agitators, acknowledge those who have brought the opportunity to let go, a chance to say farewell to the old therefore making space for the new. Meditate on releasing them with love and with gratitude.

Consolidation Questions

Where is Scorpio in your chart, what area of life does it govern? You could also look at Pluto.

Look at what's happening in your life right now. How is this path showing up? Where would stillness, removing yourself from situations, help bring a re-birth?

What notes do you have from your path tarot reading?
