



Traditionally Called **Netzach**

It's home to **Venus**, your feelings, beauty, love, art, creativity, food and nature.



How It Shows Up In Your Life

How you see the world is a personal thing, nobody can see your world your way and yet we assume they do. Maybe not all the time, but have you ever stopped to think about where the information you process comes from?

Your heart may see one thing and your head translates it as another, perception is created by both and it's understanding how everything is relative to those two things that this sphere is all about. Well, technically that's more about how this one interacts with the one before, it will all become clear!

Judging others is easy in a modern world, we can do it from the comfort of our own phones, nobody is going know right? Wrong. It has an energy of it's own, whether you like, comment or unfollow it has an energy. And so we move into the realms of pure love, beauty and of balancing our heart with our head.

Compassion

The Planetary ruler here is Venus, it is fitting that this sphere is considered the sphere of beauty, relationship and love. It's also where you establish balance between being caught up in the glamour for glamour's sake rather than simply appreciating beauty; without going starry eyed!

Through the Venus connection it also leads to the nature, to the land of green, the healing properties of Mother Nature, to Taurus, Libra through love that's unconditional. But it's also nature raw in tooth and claw, that even amongst the less pleasant images of hunter and hunted there is order.

Victory

It's Victory, but it's victory over your feelings, learning to use them as a way to establish clarity, to help you focus on a way forward based on the true nature of what you're seeing rather than an illusion. Perception is often as simple as one step back before taking one forward and tripping up on your good intentions. To overcome those urges you bring Victory, an easy example is never making decisions when you're angry. The resulting balance that occurs is the interaction between your head and heart; like science and art.

The Element of Fire

If it's not cooled then passion can be a destructive force, even with the most creative projects there is a fine line between beauty and over-doing it as well as it becoming all consuming.

Heart Brain

To the ancient Egyptians, the heart was the holder of intelligence and deep knowing; it knew what our conscious mind may not.



The Illusion is lust and promiscuity. Seen in some ancient practices where lust was dressed up in divine love, where devotion to an individual was encouraged and the devotee manipulated through the misconception that the only way to enlightenment was through physical surrender to the advances of another. But it's also manipulation through the artful glamourisation and financial wizadry used by modern day marketing techniques, clever use of images, even down to the colours that will gain the greatest response. This could be a modern take on this ancient observation of this magical sphere.

Manipulation through the heart centre, logic and the balance of the conscious mind is often forgotten, even to the detriment of your own wellbeing.



Venus

Spiritual growth occurs when the heart and the higher mind are in perfect union. You've already worked with the Mercury and his ability to talk things into being, taking what comes from Venus and making it so. But, before she does so Venus takes what she sees in the world, seeks the beauty in order to dismiss what is far from it and to then push that into the world so that you can attract like for like, love to love.

Love is the bridge that moves us from heart to head and when used properly it will walk the fierce path, the one that tempts us into being glamoured out of our true intentions through offers of big money, adoration or the false promise of someone else's power to change our own reality and emerge victorious. Tarot Cards

Seven of Wands – Lord of Valour, feeling the fear and doing it anyway! Have courage for the task ahead and believe in yourself.

Seven of Cups – Lord of Debauch, where temptation lies and lust for gain with no thought for others. Stay true to your beliefs.

Seven of Swords – Lord of Futility, no matter what you do it won't make any difference right? Not true, break free by making a difference!

Seven of Disks – Lord of Failure, you get back what you put in, so put in more and get more back! Resist negative self-talk.



Meditation

This month's meditation is an active one, it involves a prop.

Pick a rose, a red or pink one if you can, you can buy it or ask for the rose fairy's permission to pluck one, if you really must you can use a photograph, but a real one is way better.

Sit in your favourite spot, candles lit, music on is a good idea too. Then journey into the heart of the rose. Your intention is to commune with your inner heart, your heart brain.
